Guidelines for Story writing

- The story should be in English, in not more than 600-650 words.
- The story must be related to experiences of teaching, learning, outreach, inclusion, use of technology, etc.: basically anything related to school education.
- At the centre of the story, there should be a person or persons in the context of school education-therefore, the story could be about a teacher, a member of the local -self - government, a student, a parent, a volunteer, a school, etc. who did exemplar and extraordinary work, out of the routine, during this period.
- The story should revolve around this person/s and his/her/their experiences.
- The story can contain dialogues/conversations/photographs.
- Last date of Story submission is **15th February 2021.**
