1. If there are 4 blue fish, 3 yellow fish, and 2 red fish, how many fish are there in total?
2. If each blue fish has 6 stripes, how many stripes are there in total? Write in number and its number name.
3. Mrs. Turtle lays 5 eggs each day for a week. How many eggs does she lay in total? Find the answer and write its predecessor number too.
4. If there are 50 dolphins swimming in the ocean, and each dolphin can jump 7 feet high, how high can they jump altogether? Write your answer in expanded form.
5. If there are 52 seahorses, and each seahorse has 10 stripes on its body, how many stripes are there in total? Round off the number to the nearest 10.

ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

- Create your own underwater world in a plastic box or shoebox. Add colourful paper or foam shapes for the seabed, and place small toy sea animals inside. You can even add rocks or sand. Close the lid once everything is arranged, and display your creative masterpiece.
