Please Note:

- For classes III VIII, a student has to scorea minimum of 40% marks in each subject as well as in aggregate for promotion to the next class.
- For classIX, a student has to scorea minimum of 33% marks in both, the Internal Assessment and the Term Exam subject wise as well as in aggregate for promotion to the next class.
- For class XI, a student has to scorea minimum of 33% marks in both, the Theory and the Practical Exam, subject wise as well as in aggregate for promotion to the next class.
- It is mandatory to have at least 75% attendance to appear for the Annual Exam.
- If a child is not promoted after the second year in the same class, she/he must be withdrawn from the school.
- Decision of the school authorities will be final regarding the promotion.
- Progress Report is an important document of the Scholastic and Co-Scholastic achievements of a student. The same must be read carefully, signed and returned timely.
- In case of loss of the Report Card, a fine of Rs 100/- will be imposed.
