c. Animation Video- (Duration max. 3 minutes ,Size 10 Mb max)


Project questions:

b. Write about the place where it is, importance of the place, culture ,food, climate .What is it known for?


- c. While writing about the art architectural design, its measurement , use mathematical approximation to rebuild a miniature structure.
