The project was catalyzed and supported by NCSTC, Department of Science and Technology, Govt of India.

Fifty students from classes VIII and IX participated in the workshop wherein interesting team-building activities on drone making and discussion of its aerodynamics were undertaken by Captain Harish.

He enlightened the students on the history, evolution, types, and materials used for the construction of various aerodynamic models which the world has witnessed so far. The students thoroughly enjoyed the paper-based drone-making activity carried out in the workshop. Swarnprastha Public School organised a Leadership cum Adventure Camp at Nainital. The excursion was divided into two groups – the first group comprised students of classes X and XII and the second group comprised students of classes V to IX. The first group of 101 students and ten teachers with instructors had fun from 29 May to 02 June in the forested hills of Bajoon (Nainital). The second group comprising 131 students and twelve teachers with instructors left on 03 June and returned on 07 June.

The best part of the excursion was that it had the amalgamation of adventure, education, religious fervour and a feeling of preserving nature and above all delicious and nutritious food with a variety. Five - day stay away from the parents and family members taught them how to live an independent life. They learned about team work.

The students stayed in the tents in the camp and participated in various activities including Zipline, Foxline and free fall, night trekking, commando training, bonfire, cultural programmes, bird watching etc. The students were woken up at 5.00am and their activities started at 6.00am followed by breakfast and other activities. The students were appreciated and given prizes for their performance.

In their visit to Nainital the students enjoyed boating in Naini Lake, visited Nainadevi Temple, Gurudwara on lakeside, Neeb Karori Baba Ashram at Kainchi Dham and did shopping at The Mall. "One can't have more fun than playing with water on a hot day in a splash pool."




















Kids enjoyed the party in their colourful swim suits and umbrellas with lot of excitement. They filled the pool with their giggles and laughter.








STORY ENACTMENT

AMBEDKAR JAYANTI, MAHAVIR JAYANTI, VAISAKHI, HANUMAN JANMOTSAV, AND EASTER



CRAFT MAKING










